

July 4th - A Gift to Our Nation!!

The desire of every people under any kind of occupation or colonization is to be freed and gain independence from their colonizers. Hence, when we gained independence from Great Britain, on July 4, 1776, we did not only become free, but we became the beacon and model of Democracy for the nations of the world to emulate. Therefore, come July 4, our nation will joyfully celebrate our independence to remember, as well as, to honor the sacrifices made by our founding fathers, who gave up all they could to make sure that we did not have to suffer under any kind of totalitarianism or occupation.

Prudence, indeed, will dictate that Governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and accordingly all experience hath shewn, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same Object evinces a design to reduce them under absolute Despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such Government, and to provide new Guards for their future security. - Such has been the patient sufferance of these Colonies; and such is now the necessity which constrains them to alter their former Systems of Government. The history of the present King of Great Britain is a history of repeated injuries and usurpations, all having in direct object the establishment of an absolute Tyranny over these States. To prove this, let Facts be submitted to a candid world." Happy July 4th!
